## What is the church?

### Worship and Learning

It's a family who **worship together**, singing, praying, learning and socialising in friendship. We encourage our members to directly take part in worship, teaching our children or indirectly by helping to run the church.



On Sundays all our young people enjoy their own special space in **Junior Church** continuing to learn and have fun, after spending time with the grown-ups for some of the morning service.

### Once a month our 10.30 service is for **ALL AGES TOGETHER**

And don't forget the **babies!** We have a **creche** where our tinies play, well looked after by a team of volunteers, while their mums and dads worship.

Just as important, are **house groups**, which meet in members' homes and church, for Bible study and fellowship.

For teenagers, there is **SNUG**, the Sunday Night yoUth Group, a lively collection of teens enjoying a variety of activities including outings and animated discussions on many different topics.

### Service and caring

The church is a family who **care** for one another, so we have a network of carers called pastoral visitors. Nobody needs to be sick and not visited, or sad and not comforted. Flowers from our services are taken to the housebound, the sick and others in need.



Our strictly enforced **safeguarding policy** to protect all our vulnerable members and children.

**We take part in national envelope collections like Christian Aid and Action for Children, a charity rooted in Methodism.**

## Mission

We run **Alpha Courses** for those who want to know about Christianity from scratch.

Every year we choose a **project**, alternating between home and abroad, and do our best to support this cause.

We have sent cows to Africa and supported many other groups such as Daisy's Dream.

We are a **Fairtrade** church, wherever possible using fairly traded products to help support families in developing nations. We are also concerned about environmental issues and the impact we have on our world.
